

Objects of reference list.

We have made suggestions for objects/ pictures of reference; you can make changes to this list to suit your pupils. We suggest collecting the objects/ pictures prior to starting the lessons on Children's Rights.

Article 1: Everyone under the age of 18 has these rights – **Happy 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday Badge/Banner**

Article 2: All children have these rights – **Equal sign**

Article 3: Adults must do what's best for me – **a hand ('helping hand')**

Article 4: The government must make sure my rights are respected – **a picture of the Senedd or 10 Downing Street**

Article 5: The government should respect the right of my family to help me know about my rights – **A Know your Rights Poster**

Article 6 I should be supported to live and grow - **a plant/flower**

Article 7 – I have a right to a name and to belong to a country – **passport**

Article 8: I have a right to an identity – **mirror**

Article 9 – I have a right to live with a family who care for me – **Finger puppet people**

Article 10 – I have the right to see my family if they live in another country – **plane**

Article 11 – I have the right not to be taken out of the country illegally – **Article 11 symbol card**

Article 12 – I have the right to be listened to, and taken seriously – **Microphone**

Article 13 I have the right to find out and share information – **Library card/ computer**

Article 14 – I have the right to have my own thoughts and beliefs and to choose my religion, with my parents' guidance – **Religious item**

Article 15 – I have the right to meet with friends and join groups - **picture of group playing** –

Article 16 – I have the right to keep somethings private – **padlock**

Article 17 – I have the right to get information in lots of ways so long as it's safe – **Newspaper**

Article 18 – I have the right to be brought up by both parents if possible – **a picture of a family or dolls**

Article 19 – I have the right to be protected from being hurt or badly treated – **blanket**

Article 20 – I have the right to special protection and help if I can't live with my own family – **Article 20 symbols card**

Article 21 – I have the right to the best care if I am adopted – **Article 21 symbols card**

Article 22 – If I am a refugee, I have the same rights as children born in that country – **Article 22 symbols card**

Article 23 – If I have a disability, I have the right to special care and education – **school logo**

Article 24: I have the right to good quality health care, to clean water and good food – **Fruit/ Vegetable**

Article 25 – If I am not living with my family, people should keep checking I am safe and happy – a checklist

Article 26: My family should get the money they need to help bring me up – **Toy money**

Article 27 – I have the right to have a proper house, food and clothing – **Lego/ Duplo brick**

Article 28 – I have the right to an education – **Calculator/ Ruler**

Article 29 – I have the right to an education, which develops my personality, respect for others' rights and the environment – **star of the week/certificate**

Article 30 – I have a right to speak my own language and to follow my family's way of life – **speech bubble with different languages/an audio clip of different languages**

Article 31 – I have a right to relax and play – **a Ball**

Article 32 – I should not be made to do dangerous work – **hard hat/dangerous work sign**

Article 33 – I should be protected from dangerous drugs – **Medicine bottle**

Article 34 – Nobody should touch me in ways that make me feel uncomfortable, unsafe or sad – **Article 34 symbols card**

Article 35: I should not be abducted, sold or trafficked – **price tag**

Article 36 – I have the right to be kept safe from things that could harm my development - **Article 36 symbols card**

Article 37 – I have the right not to be punished in a cruel or hurtful way – **Lego jail cell**

Article 38 – I am not allowed to join the army until I am 15 – **Toy soldier**

Article 39 – I have the right to help if I have been hurt, neglected or badly treated – **Stethoscope**

Article 40 – I have the right to legal help and to be treated fairly if I have been accused of breaking the law – **handcuffs/ judges gavel**

Article 41 – Where our country treats us better than the U.N. does we should keep up the good work – **giant thumbs up or smiley face**

Article 42: Everyone should know about the UNCRC - **Article 42 symbols card**
