## Questions to think about



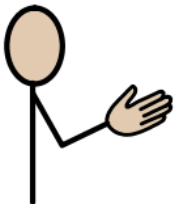
1. Do you need more people? How will you get more to join?

4. Who could help you?

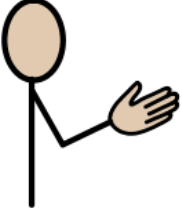
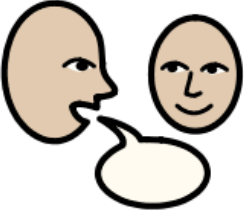

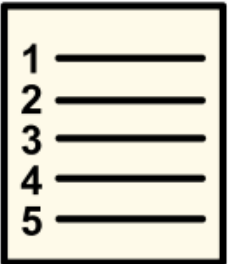

	<p><b>1. Support.</b> Does your group have a grown up to support you if you need?</p>
	<p><b>2. Check in.</b> Give a chance at the start of the meeting for everyone to say how they feel.</p>
	<p><b>3. Listen.</b> You could vote to make decisions so everyone has a say.</p>
	<p><b>4. Record.</b> Make a list of what you decide in meetings.</p>
	<p><b>5. Celebrate.</b> Feel proud of what you achieve. Share it with others through display or presentations.</p>
