Community Ambassador Mission

The mission for this term is for Ambassadors to plan their own "Haf o Hwyl" activity. This could be a whole day of fun in your setting or a series of smaller activities. This may complement plans you already have in place for the Summer Holidays.

We have created an activity pack for Community Ambassadors to lead the planning and delivery of their Haf o Hwyl activity. We suggest working with young people to think about what will be possible in your setting prior to them starting their planning session.

Haf o Hwyl is about having fun and your group's planned activities do not need to cost lots of money, if any at all, or need new equipment. We have reminded young people that their planned activities shouldn't cost a lot of money in their activity pack.

We've included some ideas for activities your group could run in the activity pack. These suggestions came from our Young People's Advisory Panel.

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How to run the mission in your setting:

- Step 1: Meet your Ambassadors and show them the activity pack
- Step 2: Work with your Ambassadors to think about any potential barriers/activities that aren't currently possible
- Step 3: Decide how you will gather young people's ideas, this may be holding a vote or asking representatives from the group to share their opinion
- Step 4: Ambassadors should plan their activity and present their ideas to you
- Step 5: Run your Haf o Hwyl activity

- Ideas about how they could hold a vote
- Ideas of activities they could run
- Ideas for how they could present the information to their link worker
