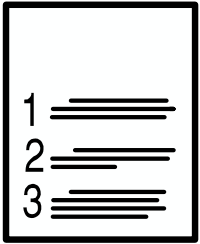


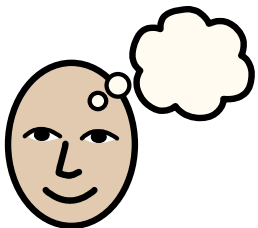

Haf o Hwyl means **Summer of Fun.**



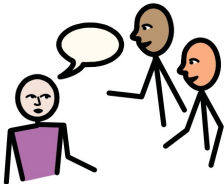
