Your Special Mission this term is to plan a Haf o Hwyl activity for your school.




Haf o Hwyl means Summer of Fun.




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Part 2: Planning

Your teacher will be able to help you make sure the activities can happen in school, and help you contact anyone you might need.






Extra Activity
