All children have human rights. These rights are listed in the UNCRC. The rights in the UNCRC set out what children need to develop, stay safe and be heard.

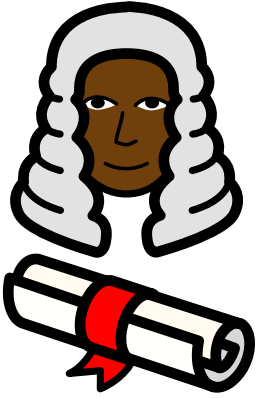


Disabled children have the same rights as other children. All the rights in the UNCRC are for disabled children.

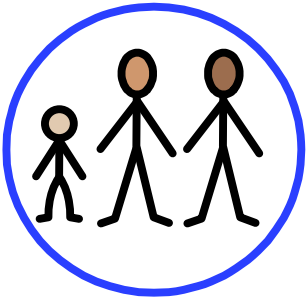


Disabled children's rights are also explained in another Convention. This convention is called the UNCRPD. It sets out what disabled people need to take part equally and be heard.

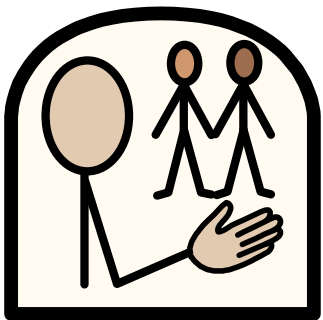
New law for education



There is a new law in Wales about how children and young people with additional learning needs, or ALN, should be supported.



This law says that children's rights must be thought about in planning education for children and young people with ALN.



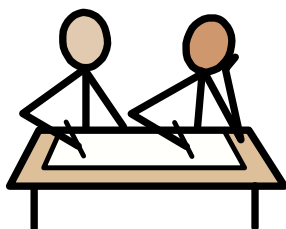
Your local authority and your health board need to think about the UNCRC and the UNCRPD when they are planning. They need to make sure that children with ALN in your area get their human rights.



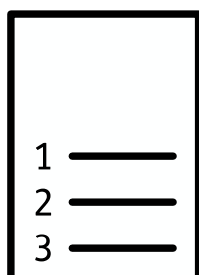
New Project
