In which ways you use The Right Way (TRW) /UNCRC in your work? Brief overview of work done and the benefits of embedding TRW/ UNCRC

Embedding – we aim to embed TRW throughout our work. Led by the Policy and Public Affairs Team, we have started an internal project to bring the work and the principles of each of the four Commissions in Wales to review where we are already making a difference and where we could do more. The aim of these groups will be to challenge and instigate new ways of working throughout the organisation, further embedding children's rights in everything we do.

Non-discrimination – our investment approach aims to ensure that we are using public money in the most sustainable way, weighting our funding towards children's participation. This will be led by data from children and young people and this will be used to target services to those who are currently missing out.

Empowerment – by working with our partners such as Street Games and the Youth Sports Trust Young Ambassadors programme, we ensure we provide information to children and young people and that they are involved in a meaningful way in our services.

Participation – We engage children and young people through our School Sport Survey and clubs and ambassador programmes.

Accountability – In particular, our investment approach which uses the School Sport Survey as a key data source is about being transparent about our decisions. Within both pieces of work, we will strive to feedback to children and young people and gather their views on the impact of our investments.
