Super Ambassadors

Over 600 teachers in Wales are signed up to the Super Ambassadors scheme.

This is how the scheme currently works:



1. Schools elect Ambassadors. Ambassadors raise awareness of the Children's Commissioner and children's rights in their school. They also take part in special missions.



2. We send special missions to schools every term (three times a year). They are designed to give you a chance to be involved in our work and make a difference to children's lives in Wales.



3. When schools join the scheme, we send them a pack of free resources. This includes, posters, ideas for learning more about rights and badges.



4. We hold events for Ambassadors in 5 locations across Wales. We also hold an event on Teams for any schools who aren't able to travel. in the events, Ambassadors get to learn more about their role and meet Rocio, the Children's Commissioner for Wales.
