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January's Monthly Matter is about children and young people's homes.

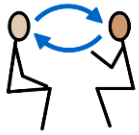

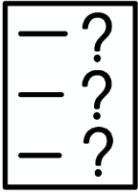


1) Discuss in pairs or as a group:
